

## Block A.

John Hogg<sup>3</sup>

A. John Hogg<sup>3</sup>, oldest son of Richard Hogg<sup>2</sup> Jr. and his wife Frances Hogg, born about 1774, married Elizabeth Hay of York County. He was named as the eldest son, and under twenty-one years old in 1794 when his father made his will.<sup>(23)</sup> His mother also named him as her oldest son when she made her will in 1800, bequeathing to him the land which had been their home.<sup>(24)</sup> He acquired more land when he purchased "126 $\frac{1}{2}$  acres from Dorothy H. Hewitt, Robert Gibbons, Mary Gibbons his wife, Ann Burt, William H. Salter and Dorothy Salter his wife in consideration of 253 pounds, lawful money to them in hand paid by the said John Hogg Jr." The deed stated that the land is "in the County of York, - - - beginning at the head of a branch of Back Creek on Back Creek road, thence down the road joining the land of John Garrett and Bernard Elliott, to the corner of said Elliott's land purchased from said tract, thence down a line of marked trees to Back Creek, thence up the said creek to the fork, thence up said fork to the center of the branch at the beginning on the road. The deed was recorded June 21, 1813."<sup>(25)</sup>

A few years later John Hogg bought of Richard Garrett 205  $\frac{3}{4}$  acres. It seems he gave a deed of trust against the property as security. The transaction, recorded in York land

books stated: "This indenture between Richard Garrett and John Hogg Jr. on April 25, 1818 - - - unto John Hogg, trustee, the following property, one tract of land about four miles below Yorktown containing by estimation 205 3/4 acres and bounded on the north by land of William Garrett, east by land of Edward Wright, south by lands of Edward Moss, west by lands of Lewis C. Charles." (26)

In addition to this property, another tract of land was mortgaged. The account stated: "also one other tract of land about six miles below Yorktown containing by estimation 130 A.; and bounded on east and south by Chisman's Creek, on west by lands of John Chapman and on the north by land of Robert Tabb where Robert Tabb now resides and the following slaves: Nat and Billey and the interest in the estate of said Frances Lee. (signed) John Hogg, Junr. At a Court held May 18, 1818." (27)

It seems that this deed of trust was not settled for several years which brought about the following transaction:

"Whereas, Richard Garrett Sr. of York County, by his deed dated April 25, 1818 which is recorded in York conveyed to John Hogg Jr. certain real and personal estate to indemnify Richard Garrett Jr. as security for Richard Garrett Sen. - - - two cases came to the court of appeals - - - Richard Garrett Jr. has paid in full and after selling the land to John Stedman there is still a deficiency and whereas the real

estate mentioned in said deed has been duly advertised to be sold, and one piece hereinafter mentioned was knocked out to Ann Garrett as the highest bidder for the sum of \$275 - - - now this indenture made and entered July 17, 1826 between said John Hogg Jr. trustee aforesaid of the first part and the said Ann Garrett of the second part - - witness that John Hogg Jr. for the sum of \$275 paid by said Ann Garrett - - - land about four miles below Yorktown, 205 3/4 A. bounded on the north by William Garrett, on the easterly by the lands of Edward Wright, south by lands of Edward Moss and on the west by lands of Lewis C. Charles."(28)

In 1827 John Hogg Jr. acquired another tract of land. "This indenture between Kemp Elliott of one part and John Hogg Jr. of the other part, whereas Robert Garrett on April 20, 1827 made a deed of trust to John Hogg Jr. - - - debt due Hogg by said Garrett who conveyed to Elliott the following tract of 230 A., sundry slaves and personal estate."

Six months later the land was sold. The record states: "On October 31, 1827 - - - exposed the said land and personal estate to sale to the highest bidder. John Hogg Jr. bought it for \$405. Kemp Elliott doth hereby acknowledge the sale."(29)

Another land item stated:

"March 17, 1828, John Hogg Jr. of the first part, Richard Whitaker the 2nd part, and Baker Lee, the third part - - - John Hogg Jr. was indebted to Lee and gave as security, 126 A., bounded on north by the main road, on south by Back Creek;

East by the land of Wm. Tabb; West by land of John Fox." (30)

It appears that John Hogg paid off this debt and got a release from the deed of trust, because in fifteen months he again gave a deed of trust against this property. It read:

"John Hogg Jr., June 3, 1829, a deed of trust to Samuel Sheild for John Bailey for \$500." He gave as security, " - - - tract of land, 126½ A. on which said John Hogg now lives, bounded on east by land of Wm. Tabb; south by Back Creek; west by land of Lewis Fox; north by land of Major Thomas Griffin and Kemp P. Elliott. (signed) John Hogg Jr." (31)

Still another deed of trust was made by John Hogg Jr., which read:

"September 1, 1829 This indenture between John Hogg Jr. and William Ware - - - Hogg gave as security 230 A. adjoining the Baptist Meeting House called Grafton, bounded on the west by Thomas Gibbs, south by the road leading over the lane Bridge to the said meeting house; east by Edward Wright; north by the land of Mary Garrett." (32)

On May 17, 1830 he was released from a "debt of \$145.39 plus interest which he owed Samuel Sheild. He made the agreement December 1, 1828 and gave as security a negro slave, Dorcas and her increase." (33)

From these several land transactions it seems safe to assume that John Hogg Jr. was a dealer in real estate and that

he owned property in more than one section of York County.

John Hogg<sup>3</sup> Jr. and Elizabeth Hay Hogg, his wife had four children:

1. Frances Hogg<sup>4</sup> born 1804;
2. Elizabeth Hogg<sup>4</sup> born 1807;
3. Thomas Hogg<sup>4</sup> born March 17, 1810<sup>(34)</sup>
4. Sarah Hogg<sup>4</sup> born ca. 1814.

A deed made in 1838 proves this relationship and identifies them, together with their spouses.<sup>(35)</sup>

It is not known when Elizabeth Hay Hogg died. John Hogg<sup>3</sup> Jr. died ca 1838. His son, Thomas Hogg<sup>4</sup> became his administrator. The inventory of his personal property was made October 23, 1838. The appraisalment and account of sales states that the sale took place November 12th and 13th, 1838. There were listed 222 items, among them being one negro man Peter, valued at \$500.00 and a negro boy William, valued at \$500.00. The negroes were not sold. The total amount of sales was \$996.81.

"The Estate of John Hogg Jr. deceased, in account with Thomas Hogg Jr. Administrator.

October 23, 1838 - Returned to Court January 17, 1842 and ordered to be recorded."<sup>(36)</sup>

Three of the children of John Hogg<sup>3</sup> Jr. and Elizabeth Hay Hogg sold the land which they heired from their father. The abstracted deed follow:

"October 11, 1838. Frances Stroud, Elizabeth Patrick, William Hogg Jr. and Sarah his wife, - - - one part, and Thomas Hogg Jr. the other part, - - - \$1250 paid by Thomas Hogg Jr. for a tract which they derived by the death of their father, John Hogg, Gentleman, and which was the residence of the said John Hogg up to the time of his death." (37)

"January 16, 1839. Frances Stroud, Elizabeth Patrick, William Hogg Jr. and his wife Sarah, one part, and Christopher Curtis other part." They sold to Christopher Curtis, 44 A. for \$83.00. Bounded on the North by William Cox's land; west by land of Henry Howard's heirs; south by land of Christopher Curtis, James Stroud's heirs and Thomas Jones, John Montgomery and Leven Smith; and on the east by William Cox's land.

(signed) Frances Stroud, Elizabeth M. Patrick  
William Hogg Jr.; Sarah Hogg." (37B)

1. Frances Hogg<sup>4</sup>, first child of John Hogg<sup>3</sup> Jr. and Elizabeth Hay Hogg, born 1804 (census), married William Stroud June 18, 1822<sup>(38)</sup>. They were first cousins as his mother was Sarah Hogg<sup>3</sup>, sister to her father, John Hogg<sup>3</sup>.

William Stroud and Frances Hogg<sup>4</sup> Stroud had four children:

- (B) A child, born ca 1830; died in childhood;

William Stroud died before March 14, 1834. On that date his widow appeared in Court and asked that her father, John Hogg Jr. be appointed to settle the estate. The record states:

"This is to certify that it is my wishes, as the administratrix of my late husband William Stroud's estate - - -; given under my hand March 14, 1834 and signed," Frances Stroud.<sup>(40)</sup> Before the estate was finally settled John Hogg, the curator, died and the Court appointed Thomas Hogg Jr. who was John Hogg's administrator to complete the settlement of William Stroud's estate.<sup>(41)</sup>

Frances Hogg<sup>4</sup> Stroud married secondly Elisha East May 2, 1840<sup>(38)</sup> and they had one son.

(E) Thomas<sup>5</sup> East who died young.

The death date of Frances Hogg<sup>4</sup> Stroud has not been recorded. A record of her descendants follows:

(A) Sarah<sup>5</sup> Stroud, first child of William Stroud and Frances Hogg<sup>4</sup> Stroud born 1827 (census), married Richard Hansford April 7, 1858.<sup>(42)</sup> They had two children.

Mrs. Georgie Hornsby Hansford died and William Crutcher<sup>6</sup> Hansford married, secondly, Anna Cornelia Hogg, granddaughter of John Hogg the younger, (43) July 3, 1884. She was born January 13, 1864. They had the following children:

Mrs. Anna Cornelia Hogg Hansford died December 16, 1912. William Crutcher<sup>6</sup> Hansford died June 11, 1920. They are buried in Zion Methodist Church Cemetery, Seaford. Of this large family of children, four died in infancy, and two died in young adulthood.
