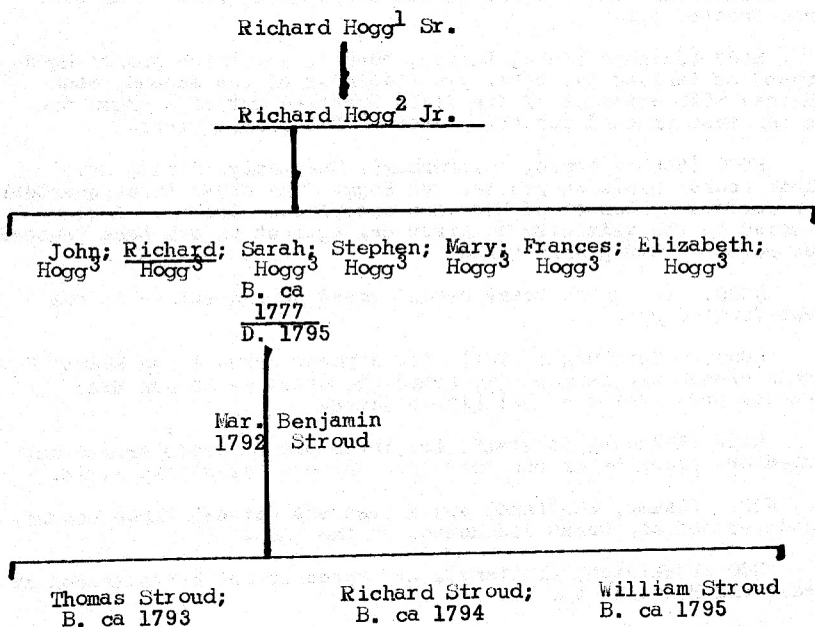

Richard Hogg³ III.

By referring to the will of Richard Hogg², it will be noted that his second son was Richard Hogg³ III, and that he was under 21 when his father made his will in 1794.⁽⁸⁶⁾ He died before 1800 leaving no descendants. This is shown by his mother's will, written in 1800 and probated October 20, 1800.⁽⁸⁷⁾ She asked that the one hundred and fifty dollars in her desk be "equally divided among my children and grandchildren", giving thirty dollars to son John, thirty dollars to son Stephen, thirty dollars to daughter Frances, thirty dollars to grand daughter Ann Jourden (only child of her deceased daughter Mary); and thirty dollars divided among her three Stroud grandsons (children of her deceased daughter Sarah). Other bequests were on a similar basis. These statements point to the conclusion that Richard Hogg³ III died unmarried, and left no descendants.

Block C.

Sarah Hogg³.

The wills of Richard Hogg² and Frances Hogg, his wife, referred to above, indicate that their third child was a daughter.

C. Sarah Hogg³, called Sally, the first named daughter of Richard Hogg² and Frances Hogg, his wife, was born about 1777. She married Benjamin Stroud about 1792. They had three children:

1. Thomas⁴ Stroud, born about 1793;
2. Richard⁴ Stroud, born ca 1794;
3. William⁴ Stroud, born ca 1795. (88)

The mother of these sons, Sally Hogg³ Stroud, died prior to January 20, 1796 according to the will of Williby Jordon, her brother-in-law. (89) He willed one half of his estate to be "equally divided betwixt" his wife's brothers and sisters, under certain conditions, and he named them. Sally's name was not included. Benjamin Stroud, the father married, secondly, Elizabeth Wright Campbell, September 4, 1799. (90) She was the widow of John Campbell and the mother of a daughter, Elizabeth Campbell whose marriage to Lewis Hogg Sr. will appear later, in this manuscript. Benjamin Stroud died in 1810 (91). William⁴ Stroud, orphan of Benjamin Stroud, deceased chose John Hogg his guardian September 20, 1813 and Thomas⁴ Stroud chose as his guardian, Seaton Elliott, November 15, 1813. (92)

On June 20, 1814 Elizabeth Stroud, widow of Benjamin and step-mother of the Stroud sons sued Thomas⁴ Stroud and William⁴ Stroud through their guardians. She asked that the

Benjamin Stroud estate be divided into three equal portions, one part to be allotted to her "in fee simple as one of the heirs of her infant children, deceased, the other two thirds to be given to the defendants."⁽⁹³⁾ This shows that the son, Richard⁴ Stroud had died prior to 1814; and when the father's estate was finally settled the property went to his widow and the two sons, Thomas⁴ Stroud and William⁴ Stroud and their heirs.

1. Thomas⁴ Stroud, first son of Benjamin Stroud and his first wife, Sarah Hogg³ Stroud, (called Sally) was born ca. 1793. He married first Anna Jordan, March 18, 1818.⁽⁹⁴⁾

They had one son,

(A) William⁵ Stroud, born 1820.

Anna Jordan Stroud died after 1822 when she was party to a deed. Thomas⁴ Stroud married, secondly, Ann Presson, December 23, 1826.⁽⁹⁵⁾ They had two children:

(B) Thomas⁵ Stroud Jr., born 1827;

(C) Polly⁵ (Mary) Stroud, born 1828.⁽⁹⁶⁾

Thomas⁴ Stroud, father of these children, died in 1832.⁽⁹⁷⁾ The appraisement and account of sales were dated March 18, 1834.⁽⁹⁸⁾

(A) William⁵ Stroud, first child of Thomas⁴ Stroud and his first wife Anna Jordan Stroud, born 1820, married, first, Catherine East February 8, 1845.⁽⁹⁴⁾ They had no children.

She died and William⁵ Stroud married, secondly Mary Cary Davis, called Polly Cary, oldest daughter of Thomas Davis and Sardelia Miller Davis of Mathews County. She was born August 13, 1816.⁽⁹⁹⁾ They had five children:

- (1) Eliza Cary⁶ Stroud born in 1847;
- (2) William Andrew⁶ Stroud, born 1848;
- (3) Seth Shepherd⁶ Stroud, born October 28, 1850;
- (4) Mary Ann⁶ Stroud, called Molly, born 1853;
- (5) Cornelius Booker⁶ Stroud, born 1853.⁽¹⁰⁰⁾

The names of their children are listed in an agreement between William⁵ Stroud, their father and John Hornsby, January 6, 1858 and recorded.⁽¹⁰¹⁾

William⁵ Stroud died in 1876. This is proved by the court record of the appraisement and settlement of his estate.⁽¹⁰²⁾

(1) Eliza Cary⁶ Stroud, born 1847, first child of William⁵ Stroud and Polly Cary Davis Stroud, married George T. Martin and had one son, Alfred Shepherd⁷ Martin who died young, unmarried. His mother died before 1877 which is proved by a deed written at that time showing that he heired his mother's inheritance from the estate of his grandfather William⁵ Stroud, who died in 1876.⁽¹⁰³⁾

(2) William Andrew⁶ Stroud, second child of William⁵ Stroud and Polly Cary Davis Stroud, born 1848, died unmarried.

(3) Seth Shepherd⁶ Stroud, third child of William⁵ Stroud and Polly Cary Davis Stroud, was born October 28, 1850. He married Alice Mills December 26, 1878⁽¹⁰⁴⁾.

She was born April 4, 1863. They had six children:

- a. Edna Marvin⁷ Stroud, born December 6, 1880;
- b. Pauline⁷ Stroud, born September 22, 1884;
- c. Woodward⁷ Stroud, born February 4, 1893;
- d. William Carlisle⁷ Stroud, born November 18, 1895;
- e. Margaret⁷ Stroud, born October 9, 1901;
- f. Stuart Aubrey⁷ Stroud, born 1903.

Seth Sheperd⁶ Stroud died September 26, 1932. His wife died November 19, 1937.⁽¹⁰⁵⁾

a. Edna Marvin⁷ Stroud, first child of Seth Shepherd⁶ Stroud and Alice Mills Stroud married, first Leroy A. Hornsby. They had one son, Paul⁸ Hornsby who married Rosa Davenport.

They have two daughters:

- (aa) Eula Rose Hornsby, and
- (bb) Edna Hornsby, both are married and have children.

Edna⁷ Stroud Hornsby married, secondly, Clarence Edward Crockett December 26, 1901. They had five children:

- (b) Elsie⁸ Crockett, born November 13, 1902;
- (c) Wilfred Travis⁸ Crockett, born June 29, 1904;
- (d) Clarence E.⁸ Crockett Jr. born August 4, 1908; died February 18, 1911;
- (e) John Thomas⁸ Crockett, born July 18, 1911;
- (f) Kathryn⁸ Crockett, born March 7, 1916.

Edna⁷ Stroud Crockett died August 13, 1956; Clarence Edward Crockett died March 6, 1961.

(b) Elsie⁸ Crockett married Horace H. Hansford, December 26, 1917. They had three children:

(aa) Doris Cornelia⁹ Hansford, born December 1, 1918, married Ashby Johnson, December 9, 1939 and they have one daughter Norma¹⁰ Johnson, born September 15, 1944.

(bb) Robert Hudson⁹ Hansford, born September 16, 1922, married Margaret Moore Harrell, June 30, 1945; they have two children, Elsie Louise¹⁰ Hansford, born September 20, 1946, and Lisa Hudson¹⁰ Hansford, born April 26, 1954.

(cc) Norma Jeanette⁸ Hansford, born March 5, 1929, married Franklin Lawson, October 11, 1952. They have two children, Franklin¹⁰ Lawson Jr. born September 3, 1953 and Katherine Anne¹⁰ Lawson, born January 8, 1955.

(c) Wilfred Travis⁸ Crockett, married Evelyn Hogg. They have two children, Janice⁹ Crockett who married Roy Mathis, and Carey Thomas⁹ Crockett who married Miss Clark in 1966.

(e) John Thomas⁸ Crockett married Lucille Gindhart and they have one adopted daughter, Sharon⁹ Crockett, who married James Freeman Jr. November 26, 1966.

(f) Kathryn⁸ Crockett married Edward Westcott. They have two sons; (aa) Clarence⁹ Westcott who married
and (bb) David⁹ Westcott,
and a daughter (cc) Sandra Kay⁹ Westcott, born February 6,

1961. (106)

b. Pauline⁷ Stroud, second child of Seth Shepherd⁶ Stroud and Alice Mills Stroud, born September 22, 1884, married first, Rodney Spencer April 18, 1905. (107) He died and she married secondly W. Joseph Wood. They had no children.

c. Woodward⁷ Stroud, third child of Seth Shepherd⁶ Stroud and Alice Mills Stroud, born February 4, 1893, married but had no children. He died May 7, 1919.

d. William Carlisle⁷ Stroud, fourth child of Seth Shepherd⁶ Stroud and Alice Mills Stroud was born November 18, 1895; died unmarried, February 24, 1918.

e. Margaret⁷ Stroud, fifth child of Seth Shepherd⁶ Stroud and Alice Mills Stroud, born October 29, 1901, married Robert A. Wood. They had two children:

(a) Marjorie⁸ Wood who married Russell Gillikin and they have five daughters, three of whom are married (1966).

(b) Robert Stuart⁸ Wood, married and has three children; Margaret⁷ Stroud Wood died July 8, 1942. (108)

(4) Mary Ann⁶ Stroud, called Molly, fourth child of William⁵ Stroud and Polly Cary Davis Stroud was born in 1853. She married Charles Henry White February 19, 1875. (109) He was born June 22, 1852. They had four children:

a. Robert Elmer⁷ White, born November 23, 1875;

b. Carrie⁷ White, born December 3, 1877;

c. Charles William⁷ White, born March 23, 1881;

- d. Mary Ann⁷ White, born September 7, 1884, died in infancy.

Molly⁶ Stroud White, mother of these children died in September, 1884.

a. Robert Elmer⁷ White married Bessie Dawson May 27, 1897. She was born September 29, 1879. They had eight children:

- (a) La Fayette⁸ White, born September 3, 1898;
- (b) Nettie⁸ White, born August 26, 1901;
- (c) Mary⁸ White, born August 16, 1904;
- (d) Robert Elmer⁸ White Jr., born June 10, 1907;
- (e) Louise⁸ White, born March 27, 1910;
- (f) Raymond⁸ White, born January 13, 1913;
- (g) Charles L.⁸ White, born November 3, 1915;
- (h) Kathleen⁸ White, born June 23, 1920.

Robert Elmer⁷ White, father of the above children, died December 18, 1952. Bessie Dawson White, the mother, died January 10, 1955.

(a) La Fayette⁸ White died November 8, 1909, aged 11 years.

(b) Nettie⁸ White, second child of Robert Elmer⁷ White and Bessie Dawson White, married Thomas Sheild Harris, May 12, 1918. They had three children:

(aa) Lorraine⁹ Harris, born March 2, 1919, married Dr. Stanley Wise White, September 7, 1941, and they had three children, Nannie B.¹⁰ White, born October 16, 1944, married Edwin Diggs, December, 1960 and has one child; Stanley W.¹⁰ White Jr., called Pete, born June 9, 1946; and Richard¹⁰

White, born October 15, 1949. Dr. Stanley Wise White died in an automobile accident August 1, 1955 and Mrs. Lorraine⁹ Harris White married, secondly William Rondeau.

(bb) Roland⁹ Harris, born January 30, 1920, married Marion Sheild June 4, 1949 and they have two sons, Roland¹⁰ Harris Jr. born October 2, 1950 and Timothy Lee¹⁰ Harris.

(cc) Thomas S.⁹ Harris Jr., born May 31, 1922; unmarried.

(c) Mary⁸ White, third child of Robert Elmer⁷ White and Bessie Dawson White, married Grady Lee Montgomery, July 10, 1921. They have two sons:

(aa) Randolph W.⁹ Montgomery, born December 27, 1922, married Jacqueline Moore, June 4, 1941, and they have five sons, David¹⁰ Montgomery, born August 15, 1942; Dwight¹⁰ Montgomery, born June 4, 1944; married in June, 1966; Jonathan¹⁰ Montgomery, born July 28, 1948; Jack M.¹⁰ Montgomery, born August 1, 1953; and Randolph W.¹⁰ Montgomery Jr. born in 1959; and

(bb) Norwood P.⁹ Montgomery, second son of Grady and Mary⁸ White Montgomery was born May 21, 1933. He is a Methodist minister, member of the Virginia Conference. He married Odessa Benbow of North Carolina, September 12, 1959 and they have two children.

(d) Robert Elmer⁸ White Jr., fourth child of Robert Elmer⁷ White and Bessie Dawson White, married Frances Boswell. They have no children.

(e) Louise⁸ White, fifth child of Robert Elmer⁷ White and Bessie Dawson White, married, first, Hunter Chalkley and they had one son:

(aa) Hunter⁹ Chalkley, Jr. born in 1929, married, first, Elizabeth Rodgers and they have one daughter, Debra¹⁰ Chalkley. Hunter⁹ Chalkley Jr. married, secondly, Deloris B. Faris, February 22, 1956.

Louise⁸ White Chalkley married, secondly, Wilton Spencer. They had no children. This marriage ended in divorce, and she resumed her maiden name, Louise⁸ White.

(f) Raymond⁸ White, sixth child of Robert Elmer⁷ White and Bessie Dawson White, married Mabel Fowler. They have one daughter, Iva Fowler⁴ White, born October 29, 1951.

(g) Charles L.⁸ White, seventh child of Robert Elmer⁷ White and Bessie Dawson White, married, first, Mildred Carter. They had two children, both of whom died in infancy. Charles L.⁸ White married, secondly, Barbara Aten, June 11, 1944. They had three children:

(aa) Robert Courtenay⁹ White, born March 9, 1949;

(bb) Charles Nixon⁹ White, born April 9, 1952;

(cc) Raymond Frank⁹ White, born in February, 1957.

Mrs. Barbara White died February 15, 1957. Charles L.⁸ White married, thirdly, Doris Hart, August 3, 1957. They have a daughter (dd) Rebecca Lynn⁹ White, born September 22, 1958.

(h) Kathleen⁸ White, eighth and youngest child of Robert Elmer⁷ White and Bessie Dawson White, married William A. Endebrock in April, 1945. They had three children:

(aa) Augustus⁹ Endebrock, born January 5, 1946; married 1966.

(bb) Robert Lee⁹ Endebrock, born and died January 13, 1948;

(cc) Willene Tully⁹ Endebrock, born January 30, 1949.

William A. Endebrock, the father, died June 11, 1948.

b. Carrie⁷ White, second child of Charles Henry White and Molly⁶ Stroud White, was born December 3, 1877. She married, first John Parker April 29, 1897. He was born March 9, 1875. They had two children:

(a) Mary Alice⁸ Parker, called Molly, born September 14, 1899;

(b) Elton Roy⁸ Parker, born January 4, 1901.

John Parker died September 14, 1911, and Mrs. Carrie⁷ White Parker married, secondly, William Swartz. They had no children. Mrs. Carrie⁷ White Parker Swartz died May 21, 1951.

(a) Mary Alice⁸ Parker married, first, Wiley Crockett, June 14, 1923. They had two daughters:

(aa) Charlotte⁹ Crockett, born July 9, 1924, married James Moore, June, 1941 and they have one son, Jimmy¹⁰ Moore, born April 8, 1944; married Shirley Gaines, 1966.

(bb) Carrie Belle⁹ Crockett, born May 30, 1928; married Merrill Nice, August 9, 1945. They have no children.

Mary Alice⁸ Parker Crockett married, secondly, George Burnett. They have no children.

(b) Elton⁸ Parker, son of John Parker and Carrie⁷ White Parker died October 6, 1940; unmarried.

c. Charles William⁷ White, called Willie, third child of Charles Henry White and Molly⁶ Stroud White, was born March 25, 1881. He married Martha Ellie Graves, May 7, 1901 and they had two children:

(a) Jack⁸ White born 1905; died July 28, 1942; unmarried;

(b) Margaret⁸ White, born 1908. She married Taylor Parker and had one child, Anna⁹ Parker. Margaret⁸ White Parker died young. Her daughter, Anna⁹ Parker married, first, Fred Colston and they had one daughter, Marion Ann¹⁰ Colston who is married.

Anna⁹ Parker Colston married, secondly, Robert Jewell. They have no children (1966).

d. Mary Ann⁷ White, fourth child of Charles Henry White and Molly⁶ Stroud White, was born September 7, 1884. She died in infancy. (110)

(5) Cornelius Booker⁶ Stroud, fifth and youngest child of William⁵ Stroud and Polly Cary Davis Stroud was born in 1853. He is identified as son of William⁵ Stroud in a land transaction October 16, 1872. (111) He died unmarried.

(B) Thomas⁵ Stroud, Jr., second son of his father, Thomas⁴ Stroud, Sr., and first child of his second marriage to Ann Presson, was born in 1827. (112) He lived to maturity and did not marry.

(C) Mary⁵ (Polly) Stroud, third child of his father, Thomas⁴ Stroud Sr. and second child of Ann Presson Stroud, was born in 1828. (112) She died unmarried.

Ann Presson Stroud, mother of Thomas⁵ Stroud Jr. and Mary⁵ (Polly) Stroud, above, died in 1857. The settlement

of the estate took place in May, 1857. (113)

2. Richard⁴ Stroud, second son of Benjamin Stroud and Sarah (Sally) Hogg³ Stroud was born about 1794. He died young and did not inherit from his father's estate when it was settled in 1811-1814.

3. William⁴ Stroud, third son of Benjamin Stroud and Sarah (Sally) Hogg³ Stroud was born about 1795. His mother died before January 20, 1796, as already stated. In 1810 he chose John Hogg Sr. as his guardian. This was repeated at a court held September 20, 1813. His grand-mother, Frances Hogg, named him as one of her three Stroud grandsons in her will in 1800. (114) William⁴ Stroud married his cousin, Frances Hogg⁴, daughter of John Hogg³ Jr. and Elizabeth Hay Hogg, June 18, 1822. (115)

William⁴ Stroud and wife Frances, and his brother Thomas⁴ Stroud and his wife Anna, gave one acre of land in Crab Neck (Seaford) on which the first Methodist church of this area was built. The deed was dated December 20, 1822, (116) and is still a part of the Zion Church property (1966).

The descendants of William⁴ Stroud and his wife Frances Hogg⁴ Stroud have been traced earlier in this chapter under descendants of John Hogg³ Jr., the father of Frances, therefore a listing here of them would be repetitious and monotonous. It may be noted that their oldest daughter Sarah⁵ Stroud married Richard Hansford and had many descendants;

their second child died in childhood, their third child Robert⁵ H. Stroud left no descendants, and the fourth, Rebecca⁵ Stroud never married .

This brings to a close the tracing of descendants of C. Sarah Hogg³, daughter of Richard Hogg² Jr. and grand-daughter of Richard Hogg¹ Sr.
