## Couch

Isaac S. Couch<sup>1</sup>, born 1817 (1850 census, New Kent County, Va) died January 27, 1867 (from Aunt Lizzie's old record, enclosed) married Sarah Ann Brittan born 1821 (New Kent Co. 1850 census), died January 1881 (Aunt Lizzie's old record).

Both were from New Jersey and settled in New Kent County Va. From the 1850 Census of New Kent Isaac Couch was born in New Jersey and was 33 years old (in 1850); Sarah Couch was born in New Jersey and was 29 years old (in 1850). The first two children were born in New Jersey the census states, and other children were born in Virginia. This indicates the family moved to New Kent County, Va. between late 1841 and December 1843.

Isaac Couch had a sister named Eliza, who was bitten by a squirrel & died of hydrophobia

The following pages will record a combined study of the families of Couch and Sparrow (Sparrer).

Since Mary Frances Couch<sup>2</sup>, the oldest child of Isaac Couch<sup>1</sup> and Sarah Ann Brittan Couch, married Thomas Washington Sparrow, a detailed account of her descendants will be given in the Sparrow section of this paper.

The narrative at this point, picks up the genealogical tracing with the second Couch child - James Watson Couch<sup>2</sup>, and continues through the ninth child, Elizabeth (Lizzie) Davis Couch<sup>2</sup>.

Then the descendants of I. Mary Frances Couch<sup>2</sup> will be given in detail as Sparrow - Couch genealogy.

 be paid after my death & all my just debts paid  
 by my after named Executor & I also wish my wife  
 Sarah Ann Couch to hold all my estate during her  
 life. After her death I wish my estate to be equal  
 divided between my children. My daughter, Mary  
 Frances Sparrow, formerly Couch, I lend her share to  
 her life & after her death I give her share to her chil-  
 dren. Also I leave my two boys James W. Couch & Jo-  
 W. Couch as trustees for Mary F. Sparrow's share of  
 my estate, thro' (they) to control the same & deal  
 same out to her as they may think proper or she  
 may need. Given under my hand & seal this the  
 9<sup>th</sup> day January 1867.

first child of Isaac S. Couch<sup>1</sup> and his wife Sarah Ann Brittan Couch was born in New Jersey (1850 New Kent County Va. Census) December 12, 1839. She married

Thomas Washington Sparrow July 12, 1858.

Thomas Washington Sparrow (Sparrow) died December 24, 1879.

II. James Watson Couch<sup>2</sup>, second child of Isaac S. Couch<sup>1</sup> and his wife Sarah Ann Brittan<sup>Couch</sup> was born in New Jersey, according to the 1850 New Kent County Census, on October 8, 1841, and died December 13, 1919. (Tombstone). He was called "Uncle Watson". He served in the Civil War, from New Kent County, Va., in the Southern Confederate Army.

He never married. He is buried in the Church Cemetery at Pamunkey Methodist Church in New Kent County, Virginia.

III. John Wesley Couch<sup>2</sup>, third child of Isaac S. Couch<sup>1</sup> and Sarah Ann Brittan Couch was born in Virginia (Census) December 7, 1843. He died in 1917.

He married, first, Mary E. Williams January 24, 1876. She was the daughter of Hugh and Harriett Williams and was 24 years old when married (born 1852) according to the New Kent County marriage register. She died May 1883 of consumption. Age given at that time was 28 years. This is found in the Death Register of New Kent County Clerk's Office. (Note the difference account of her birth date)



John Wesley Couch<sup>2</sup> married, secondly, Sarah J. Hardin, November 26, 1884. She was born October 12, 1866 and died December 11, 1919. (See her tombstone). She was the daughter of Hezekiah and Mary Carolyn Hardin. Rev. Thomas P. Wise officiated. She is buried in the cemetery of Corinth Baptist Church at New Kent Court House.

Thompson of New Kent County, August 28, 1920. She was 21 years of age at the time of her marriage, the daughter of John and Elizabeth Thompson of New Kent. They had one daughter :

V. Hester Ann Couch<sup>2</sup>, fifth child of Isaac S. Couch and Sarah Ann Britton Couch, was born August 12, 1849. She married William P. Mills, September 16, 1879. He was son of William H. and Frances T. Mills, He was 50 years old when he married Hester Ann Couch<sup>2</sup>, and was a widower. Ceremony was performed by Rev. George W. Wray. They had six children:

VII. Isaac S. Couch<sup>2</sup> jr. seventh child of Isaac S. Couch<sup>1</sup> and Sarah Ann Brittan Couch was born April 22, 1853. He married Ellen J. Wright, February 9, 1876, daughter of Chambliss and Emmaline Wright. Rev. Thomas P. Wise officiated. She was born January 31, 1855. (Marriage from New Kent Marriage Register).

They had five children:

On a Saturday afternoon in January, 1955 I went to call on Uncle Jim Sparrow (James Wesley Sparrow) to have him talk to me about Family.

He verified the names of the brothers and sisters of his father, Thomas Washington Sparrow as I had recorded them, from information given me by my mother-in-law, Mrs Sarah Elizabeth Sparrow Ironmonger. Both of these relatives said that their grand-mother was Miss Emmaline Morgan.

Uncle Jim also said:

"Old man Tom Sparrow's father (Jacob) and my father's father, were brothers. Nester Sparrow was old man Tom Sparrow's daughter by his first wife, before he married Carey Crockett's daughter, Laura."

"My father's father had a sister, Sukiie Sparrow who married Washington Marshall. They had several sons, George Marshall and Henry Marshall being among them. The latter married Elvira Ironmonger."

"There were three Morgan sisters:

1. Emmaline Morgan, my grand mother;
2. Georgianna Morgan, who lived with Aunt Mary French.
3. Julia Morgan, who married William Sterling.

Emmaline Morgan Sparrow grew to manhood. He was drowned in the Elizabeth River, Norfolk County when the main-sheet on the vessel he was sailing, broke and he was swept into the river. He was unmarried.

This scanty information on the brothers and sisters of Thomas Washington Sparrow<sup>2</sup> was given to me by three of his children, Mrs. Sarah Elizabeth Sparrow Ironmonger, James Wesley Sparrow and Mrs. Mary Hester Sparrow Parker.

IV. Thomas Washington Sparrow<sup>2</sup>, fourth child of William Thomas Sparrow and Emmaline Morgan Sparrow, the central figure of this family sketch, and the ancestor of the York County, Virginia branch of Sparrow-Sparrow was born in 1832. Thomas Washington Sparrow<sup>2</sup> married secondly, Mary Frances Couch<sup>2</sup>, July 12, 1858, thus the tracing of their descendants provides data for the Couch - Sparrow (Sparver) Study.

Uncle Jim Sparver said:

"Thomas Washington Sparrow was in the biggest hurry to get married. He ran many schooner-loads of cord wood out of New Kent to New York while he was a widower. He hired a cook in New York. They bought chickens by the coop-full, to have, to cook on his boat. He carried young Mary Couch on a trip or two to Norfolk. After his second marriage he stopped running the schooner and bought a farm

Thomas and Mary Sparrow lived in Hanover County August 4, 1863 (New Kent County Rec.

Book 1, page 93) and in Middlesex County  
January 18, 1876 (New Kent County Deed Bk 2, p 369)

Each of these records refer to their sel-  
ing land in New Kent County.

It was in Middlesex that he contracted  
a cold and was never well again. They  
moved to York County, Virginia, where he  
died in 1879. He did not own land in  
York County.

These scant records of Thomas W. Sparrow  
seem to agree with the few lines that  
his son James W. Sparrow (Uncle Jim) gave me  
in January 1955.

The land transactions of Thomas W.  
Sparrow in New Kent were for the purpose  
of procuring timber, to supply the cord-  
wood which he ran by schooner to New  
York, for sale there. Thus he would buy a  
tract of land, cut over the timber, then  
offer the land for re-sale, as he pur-  
chased other tracts of land to carry on  
his trade.

Cunt Mary Sparrow Parker told

50

me the following story:

Mary Couch went to a friend's house, a new house in New Kent. The mother of the girl in this home said, "you girls try your fortune tonight (which was Saturday) with your string garters." You do it this way:

Take the garter off, hold it over your head, walk backwards and tie a knot for each step you take, back to the wall; then roll up the garter and put it under your pillow, and without speaking again, go to bed and dream.

The two girls did this, and Mary Couch dreamed that she was at home and there was a tall handsome dark-haired man, standing by the door post. William Allen Adkinson (the other boy) chased her three times around the house, to kiss her. The other man smiled. Sunday morning the dream woke her up.

Two or three weeks later Mary went home from church with Eleanor Vaughan.

That Sunday, Thomas Washington Sparrow, of Norfolk, was also at the Vaughan home. He owned a schooner and ran cord wood from New Kent to New York on his big boat.

Before Mary had seen him, Mrs Vaughan said

"Come on Mary and wash your hands;  
I've got a bean for you."

As Mary came toward the door, there stood the tall, handsome, dark-haired young man by the door-post, just like her dream. Mary almost fainted. Later, they were married. <sup>21</sup>

Some explanation is due for the difference in spelling of the name Sparrow - Sparrer.

All available early records gave the spelling as SPARROW until after the second marriage of Thomas Washington Sparrow, who decided to change the spelling.

It seems that Thomas Washington Sparrow objected to his name being the same as a bird, which he interpreted as being a little less than complimentary, and from that time on, he spelled his name SPARRE and all of the descendants of his second marriage have adopted the new spelling - Sparrer - .

The following was told me by my mother-in-law, Mrs. Sarah Elizabeth Sparrer Ironmonger:

" Thomas Washington Sparrer (Sparrow) and his wife Mary Couch Sparrer, moved to Crab Neck, York County, Va. - The exact date is not known, now. They rented a home in the lower section (Eastern) of the community, on Chismans

Creek; on the Whittington Crockett tract, the dwelling house was in sight of the Crockett family cemetery, which is situated on rather low land.

A death in the Crockett family and burial in the Crockett cemetery, while Thomas Sparver was in his last illness, caused him to request his family to have his body carried to Norfolk, when his death should occur, because of the low marshy land in the cemetery, close by. He wanted to be buried by his mother in Norfolk, Virginia.

His sister Mary Ann Sparrow French and men of the family who lived in Norfolk, came to Crab Neck by sail boat to visit him while he was bed-ridden, expecting to carry his body back with them for burial. He rallied, temporarily, and the relatives had to return to their home.

When he died December 24, 1879, severe winter weather made it impossible to take his body by sail boat (the only means of transportation available then) to Norfolk. As an alternative, his cousin Catherine (Puss) Sterling Bunting suggested

to the widow that the body be buried in Providence Methodist Church cemetery in Fish Neck (now called Dare) beside her late husband ~~Theodore~~ Bunting.

Since no burials had taken place as early as 1879 in Zion Methodist Church yard in Crab Neck, except three or four unknown soldiers of the Civil War, Mrs. Sparrer accepted the cousin's offer of a burial site in the Providence Cemetery, intending to have him re-interred in Norfolk, later. This was never done. Dates are engraved thus on his tomb stone:

"Thomas Washington Sparrer  
Born 1832; Died December 24, 1879."

Obituary of William Thomas Sparrer<sup>4</sup>; 1918:

Some thirty years ago a young couple William Sparrer and his bride, Nora Crockett, both of York County, Virginia — settled upon the banks of one of the beautiful rivers for which this old historic county is far-famed, and there established a home, one in which love and contentment, peace and piety abounded, and one over which God reigned and was loved and honored.

Two children — William Jr. and Mary — now Mrs. Luther Amory — were born to this godly couple, and they were early dedicated to the Lord and are still following their parents in the Heavenly way.

The family circle continued unbroken 'til October 5, 1918 when its head - "Captain Billie" as he was familiarly known - was called away to his home on high, leaving a vacant chair in his earthly home and sad, mourning hearts, which long "for a touch of the vanishing hand and the sound of a voice that is still."

Brother Sparrow was a quiet, unobtrusive, unpretentious Christian gentleman, one whose place in the church of God and of his choice - Zion, Methodist, York Circuit was always filled unless he was unavoidably kept away. No slight excuse prevented his being at Sunday School and public worship service.

His voice, however, was seldom heard in these gatherings, except in prayer or in testimony. He never formerly expressed his opinions though they were well-formed and of great worth. His extreme modesty prevented any display of them. His pastor, however, knew he could always be depended upon for good advice and counsel as well as for his earnest co-operation in "any good word and work. His heart was in the work of the

Lord, and how he and his devoted wife and children did love to entertain those engaged in carrying on this work! No expense nor trouble was worth considering when their pastor came under their roof-tree, and these pastors of past years will always recall with tender recollections the happy hours spent there, and the words of sympathy and encouragement, as well as substantial deeds of kindness, bestowed upon them by its inmates.

? One striking characteristic of Brother Sparrow was his spirit of charity to all with whom he was associated. I knew him intimately for four years, and I do not recall in hearing him say one harsh word concerning anyone; but was ever looking for and finding some good in a fellow-man and throwing always the mantle of charity over any apparent defect.

The highest and best of his life was shown in his home. Affectionate, kind, tender-hearted and self-sacrificing, he drew and bound to him the members of his family, in a loving bond — a bond which death has severed, but which God has "fastened firm to the skies" out of which

He is whispering:

"I love thee, I love thee; Pass under the rod."

For many, many months Brother Sparrow was an invalid, suffering intensely, but through all his suffering and weariness, he was ever patient and quiet by submission to the Divine will, and when the end came he assured his faithful and loving wife that all was well with him, that there was nothing to fear, and trustfully and confidently, he met the "grim destroyer" not as such, but as a messenger from his Heavenly Father, bidding his weary child come home.

On October 7, 1918 his funeral sermon was preached by Brother Alonza Topping, a local preacher of the East York Circuit, after which amidst mourning loved ones and friends his sympathetic neighbors carried his body to the church-yard at Zion and laid it away in the lap of Mother Earth, to sleep till Jesus "shall bid him arise, to hail Him in triumph ascending the skies."
