This Deed made and entered into this twentieth day of August
eighteen hundred and sixty eight by and between Thomas Hogg,
and Catherine Jane Hogg husband and wife of Montgomery
County and State of Missouri parties of the first part, and Thome
J. Hughes of Gloucester County and State of Virginia party of the
second part, witnesses, that the said parties of the first part in con-
sideration of one thousand two dollars to them paid by the said party of
the second part, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do by the
presente Grant Bargain and sell, convey and confirm unto the said
party of the second part the following described real estate situated
in Gloucester County and State of Virginia and described and
bound as follows, to wit: on the north by the land that was allotted to
James Ligh in right of his wife who was Emma Hayes on the
East by the land of Ed. H. Rowe being part of the said tract, on
the South by the main road leading to saddle creek and the land
that was allotted to George Hayes under the will of John Hogg
deceased, on the West by the lands of Thomas J. Hughes, the above
named grantee, called and known by the name of Colman,
being the same land that was given to Thomas Hogg, the
above named grantor, under the will of his father John Hogg
deceased, to have and to hold, the same, together with all the
rights, immunities, privileges and appurtenances to the same
belonging to the said party of the second part, and to his heirs
and assigns forever; The said Thomas Hogg hereby con-
-anting that he, his heirs, executors and administrators shall
and will Warrant and defend the title to the premises, to the
said party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns
forever, against the lawful claims of all persons.

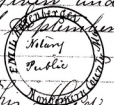
