

## A COMPILATION OF SOME VIRGINIA RECORDS

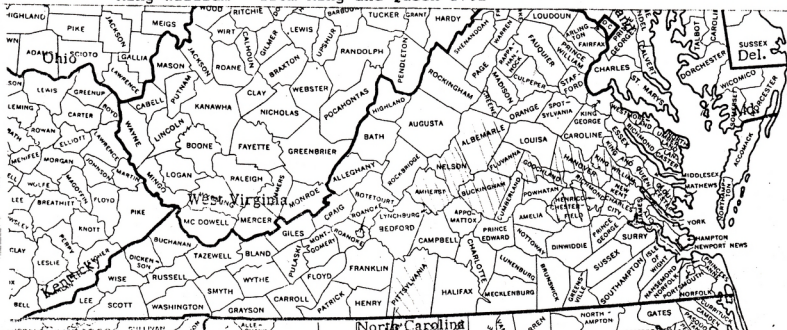

"HOGG, JOHN, - Declaration of Susannah HOGG, Henry Co., Tenn., March 3, 1849, aged 88, widow of John HOGG who enlisted 1779 or early in 1780 under Capt. or Col. MCKEE in the Virginia Troops & was discharged 1782. They were married by Rev. CRAWFORD April 14, 1779 in Amherst Co., VA and moved to the frontiers of VA & Stationed at a fort on the Kanawha River where they both stood guard. He died in Garrard Co., KY, June 12, 1802. Goolsby CHILDRESS testified he served as mess-mate of John HOGG in the infantry during the Revolutionary War. In 1823, Susannah HOGG was living in Logan Co., KY. Her claim was allowed.

Susannah HOGG is on the 1840 census of Henry Co. TN #482. There is also a John C. HOGE (I have seen a deed which says he is John C.M. HOGG)

Then, there is a letter from a correspondant - David B. DOLLARD [REDACTED]

"...I am a widower, researching the families of all of my children's ancestors. Lucy HOGG, daughter of John HOGG was my wife's 4 gr grandmother. Although my database contains 488 descendants of John HOGG (not including spouses), I have done no research on the HOGG family so far."

"...here is what I have on the first two generations of John HOGG:

"(1) John HOGG married on 14 April 1779 in Amherst Co. VA (?) who was born in 1761. John died on 12 Jun 1802 in Garrard Col KY. Susannah died in Aug 1849 in Henry Co. TN. During the Revolutionary War John enlisted under Capt. MCGEE in the Virginia Troops and was discharged 1782. SOURCES: SOME DESCENDANTS OF JOHN SLEDD BY VAN A. STILLEY. Dear Cousin:

Thanks for your package of Hogg material and letter of 27 August.

Enclosed is the will of Solomon Carter, whose wife ran away with John Goodrich and was named in the latter's will written 20 Feb 1804, you cited among "Wills of Amherst County (Va.) 1761-1865". I do not know Mary Ann's maiden name, but do know that she was not Mary Ann Ellis, as claimed in *Descendants of Captain Thomas Carter, 1652-1912*, by Joseph Lyon Miller, 1917, Harrisonburg, Va.: C. J. Carrier Co., 1972. Miller got many things wrong, some of them intentionally, as when he rearranged some families in order to avoid bastardy. All of John Goodrich's children were by an earlier wife or wives, unidentified to me.

Your "Descendants of John Hogg" pedigree chart shows John Hogg<sup>2</sup> married Susannah (?) 14 Apr 1779 in Amherst Co., Va. This is the Susannah who served with her husband at Fort Kanawha, and his widow after he died in Garrard Co., Ky., 12 Jun 1802. Susannah and her children moved a lot. They seem to have been in Washington Co., Ky., in 1819 when she sold 34 acres in Amherst to Milbourn Hogg (probably her brother-in-law who married Martha Peter 5 Oct 1801 in Washington Co., Ky., where he died testate in 1854.) By 1820, Susannah and children were in Sumner Co., Tenn., and in 1823 they were in adjacent Logan Co., Ky., where she made one of several attempts to secure a pension based on her husband's service (# W7763). The names of her children and their birth dates came from one of those applications. Later, she said her Logan Co. lawyer, John Breathett, "lost her papers". He went on to become a Governor of Kentucky. Susannah and her brood moved to Henry Co., Tenn., where, in March 1849, she tried again for a pension. She died there five months later, in August 1849, at about age 88. Susannah's last pension effort was supported by an affidavit from Lucy (Hogg) Sledd<sup>2</sup>, who then was living in adjacent Calloway Co., Ky., with her dead son John Sledd's widow Mary (Carter) and family. Sisters-in-law, Lucy and Susannah may have been neighbors within shouting distance, albeit across a State line—certainly they were in contact. Lucy (Hogg)<sup>2</sup> Sledd was a sister of Susannah's deceased husband, John Hogg<sup>2</sup>.

Your chart shows that Lucy Sledd had died 1818 in Amherst Co., Va. This is not correct; she died in Calloway Co., Ky., some time between 1853 and 1860. There was a Lucy Sledd who died 1818 in Amherst, but not this one. The one who died in 1818 was Lucy (Peter), wife of Barksdale Sledd. The DAR ladies have known about this for a long time, but, as is their custom, have failed to correct their records, e.g., Twila Luger Graves' application compounding this error. Barksdale Sledd was a brother of William Sledd, husband of Lucy (Hogg) Sledd<sup>2</sup>. Another sister of John<sup>2</sup> and Lucy<sup>2</sup> was Elizabeth Hogg<sup>2</sup> who married Zedekiah Shoemaker. One of their brothers, I believe, was your Samuel Hogg<sup>2</sup> who married Barbara York (were "Delphia" and Barbara the same?).

I have John Hogg<sup>1</sup>, father of the above siblings<sup>2</sup>, as born 7 Mar 1739 in Hanover Co., Va., died 16 Jan 1814 in Amherst Co., Va., and married to Lucy (?). It looks like John Hogg<sup>1</sup> may be the same man as Jonathan Hogg who died "before 1819", when (his widowed daughter-in-law) Susannah (?) Hogg "of Washington Co., Ky." sold those 34 acres on Maple Creek, Amherst Co., Va. Supposedly, this John<sup>1</sup> was not a son of Gideon Hogg, but a son of Milbourn Hogg<sup>0</sup> (born 5 Feb 1707, Hanover Co., Va.; died 12 Apr 1764, where?) and wife Lucy Webb (no dates or parents). These data came from Shirley Ann Whitaker's DAR application, # 509593. A good guess for parents of this Milbourn Hogg<sup>0</sup> is William Hogg<sup>1</sup> (born 6 Mar 1676, New Kent Co., Va.; died 17 Nov 1749,

where?) and wife Rachel Cooper (no dates or parents). William<sup>1</sup> allegedly was a son of John Hogg<sup>2</sup> and Mary Neeley. Would you like my file in GEDCOM, Roots III, or WordPerfect on a 3 1/2" diskette?

In Kentucky, the Jackson Purchase includes the eight counties west of the Tennessee River, which was the main highway from the Carolinas west during most of the 19th Century. That river forms the eastern boundary of Henry Co., Tenn., and of adjacent Calloway Co., Ky. Proceeding downstream, north, within a day's float from Henry/Calloway, one could land in Livingston Co., Ky., (on the right) where the Tennessee meets the Ohio (near Paducah, McCracken Co., on the left) about a hundred miles east of the Mississippi-Ohio confluence. Thousands of people took that route, including, I expect, Bob Wagner's ancestors. I will send him, Dave Dollard, and Carol Knuppel copies of this letter, although I do not believe Bob's ancestor Eliza (Hogg) Jones was Susannah's daughter; maybe one of her husband's nieces.

A researcher with a lifetime of Hogg research under her belt is Lavelle Cox Hogg, at [REDACTED]. She is thorough and meticulous.

This letter had reached this point when Fran visited.

At last count, I lost ten pines. One of them was on the house and had to be dealt with quickly. Two standing trees were discovered to have loosened roots and were leaning so they might have come down on my neighbor's house; so, had to be cut. My roof does not leak. So many shingles were lost, however, that the insurance adjuster said they would pay for a new roof and about five feet of crushed soffit and fascia board, new chain link fence (in the back), and reimbursement for hauling away the trees that collapsed the old one, as well as the one on the roof. No figures have been mentioned. It must be too early for that. The insurance people are swamped with urgent matters. None of mine qualifies as urgent, now that the roof is treeless.

The power was off for six days. The temperature was in the 90s most days, with a year's worth of rain in the following week. My neighborhood was not flooded; many were. Snakes were disturbed; some have emerged from the ground to bite people. There are swarms of insects—no birds around to eat them, or squirrels. I have four fire ant bites and poison ivy on feet from clearing debris in the yard. Everything in the refrigerator had to be thrown out. Insurance will not cover that. The radio said one of the imported electric restoration teams was from Paducah, Ky., my birth place. I wish I could have seen their trucks; would have been happy to greet them personally.

When the power came back on, I felt like a child on Christmas. It was so good to take a hot bath, have TV to see what is going on beyond this block, lights, air conditioning, refrigerator, stove, dish washer, and all the other things one uses without thought.
